- 1. By faith, Noah built an ark.
  - 1. Noah believed God when told of coming judgment. Gen 6:13
  - 2. Noah obeyed God's command to build an ark. 6:22
  - 3. God brought all those who would be saved to the ark. 6:20
  - 4. Noah responded to God's invitation to enter the ark and be saved. 7:1
  - 5. The flood of God's judgment destroyed everyone and everything that was not in the ark. 7:21
  - 6. All those in the ark passed through death and were brought out into a new life. Gen 8:15-9:1
- 2. God prepared an ark for our salvation.
  - 1. The way to righteousness is through Jesus Christ alone. Rom 3:21-26
  - 2. Jesus obeyed the Father's command to become one like us, yet he was without sin. Heb 5:7-10; 4:15
  - 3. The way "into" Jesus is by the drawing of the Father. Jn 6:65, 37
  - 4. The invitation to come must be accepted in order to be saved. Jn 3:16; Heb 3:12-19

- 5. The wrath of God's righteousness will condemn all who are not "in Christ."
  - 1. We must be identified with Christ through baptism into his death and resurrection. 1 Pet 3:18-22
  - 2. All of us must be baptized by the One Spirit. 1 Cor 12:12f.
  - 3. If we have the Spirit of Christ, we have Christ. Rom 8:9
- 6. All who are in Christ have died and will be raised to a new life. Rom 8:11; 2 Cor 5:17; Heb 6:18; 2 Cor 5:1-5
